he tore the bars away, Jesus my Lord! [Refrain]

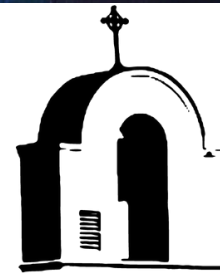
